Program Overview

Whether you're actively seeking employment or wish to map out your near- and long-term career path, the Career Program will help you to establish career goals and take the actions necessary to achieve them.

This dynamic, highly interactive course will empower you to take control of your career with proactive job search techniques and career management strategies.

Don't be a victim of the current job market—take action to learn where you fit in, decide on next steps, identify and leverage new trends and technologies, and actively influence your future.

In this 15-week course you will:

- Build an action-oriented career plan
- Create a portfolio showcasing your talents
- Expand your professional network
- Polish your interviewing skills
- Identify hidden employment opportunities
- Cultivate a new life-long strategy for turning your talents into income

Students will earn 8 credits from UCSD Extension.

Program Schedule

The program runs 15 weeks. Courses sessions take place during the day, with additional assignments to be completed outside of class or online, and counseling to be arranged with a career coach.
