Position overview:

This internship is designed to provide interns with insights into IT operations and support, enhance their technical skills, and expose them to a wide range of technologies and IT best practices.

Skills the intern will have:

- **Basic Systems and Technologies:** Understanding of fundamental IT systems and technologies, including operating systems, hardware components, and software applications.
- **Computer Networking:** Familiarity with computer networking principles, protocols, and network configurations, including the ability to troubleshoot network issues.
- **Governance and Risk:** Awareness of IT governance principles and the ability to assess and mitigate risks related to IT operations and projects.
- **Hardware and Equipment:** Basic knowledge of computer hardware, including setup, maintenance, and troubleshooting of desktops, laptops, etc.
- **IT Security:** Basic understanding of IT security concepts, including data protection, access control, and awareness of cybersecurity best practices.
- **Systems Testing:** Assist in systems testing, including setting up test environments, running test cases, and documenting results for IT projects.

Expectations:

Interns will work with host companies to determine if work will be done virtually or in-person. Internships will be a maximum of 240-hours total beginning in mid-May at the earliest and ending in September at the latest.
